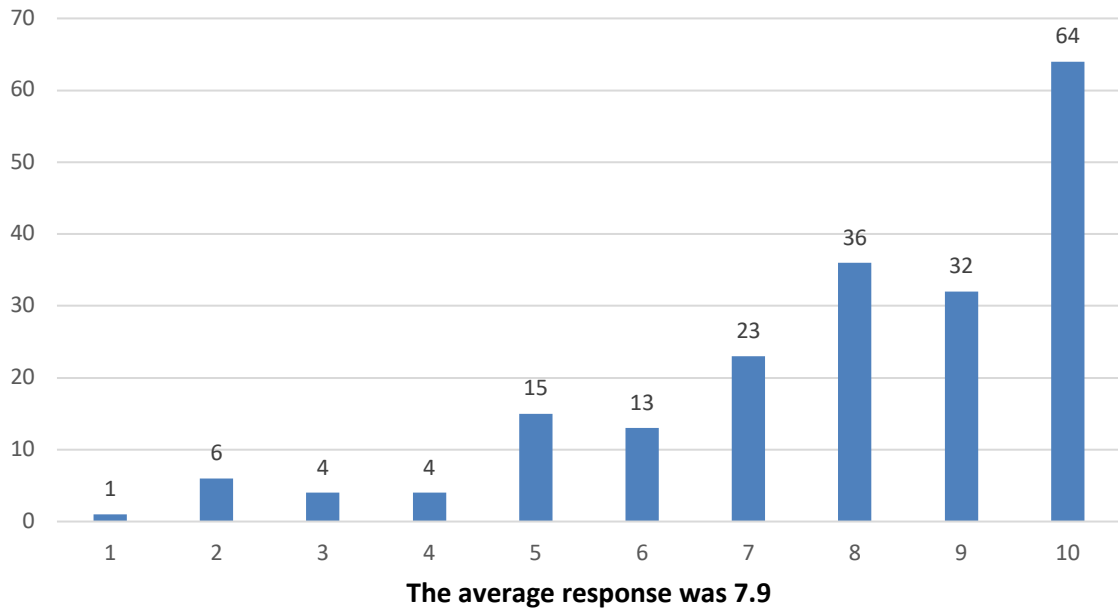
1.1 Reduction in the number of child cases (age < 15 years) of leprosy by 90% from 2018 levels, by 2030.

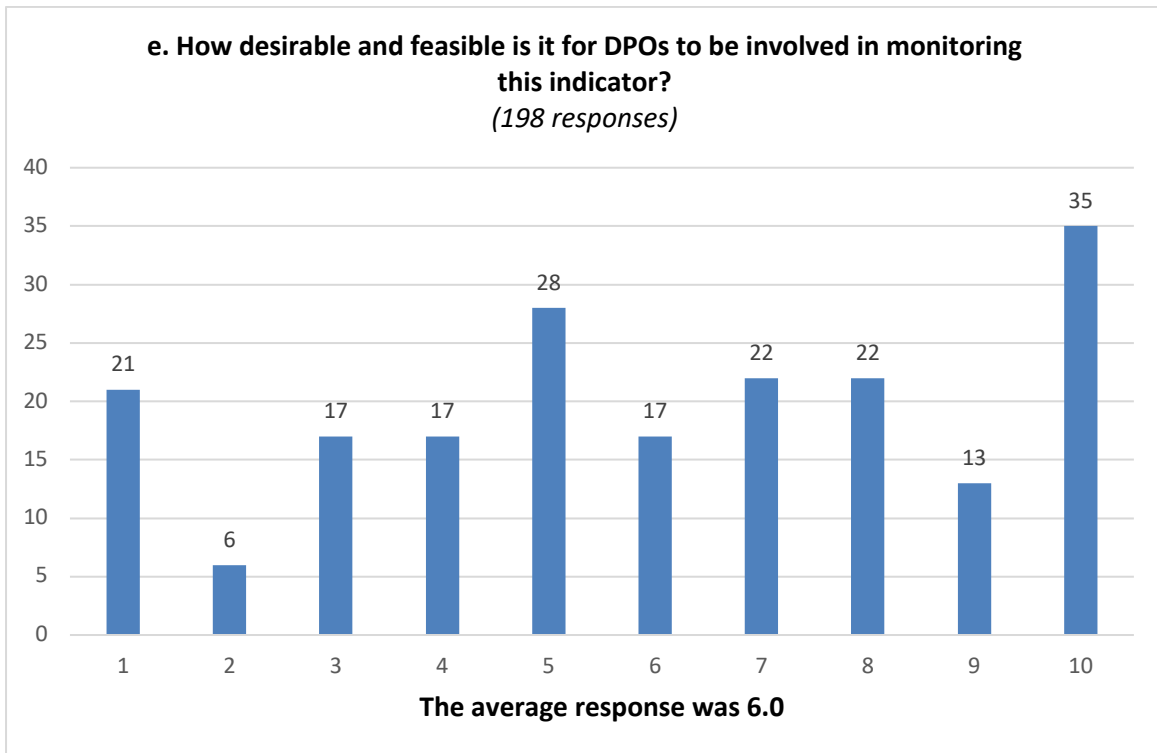
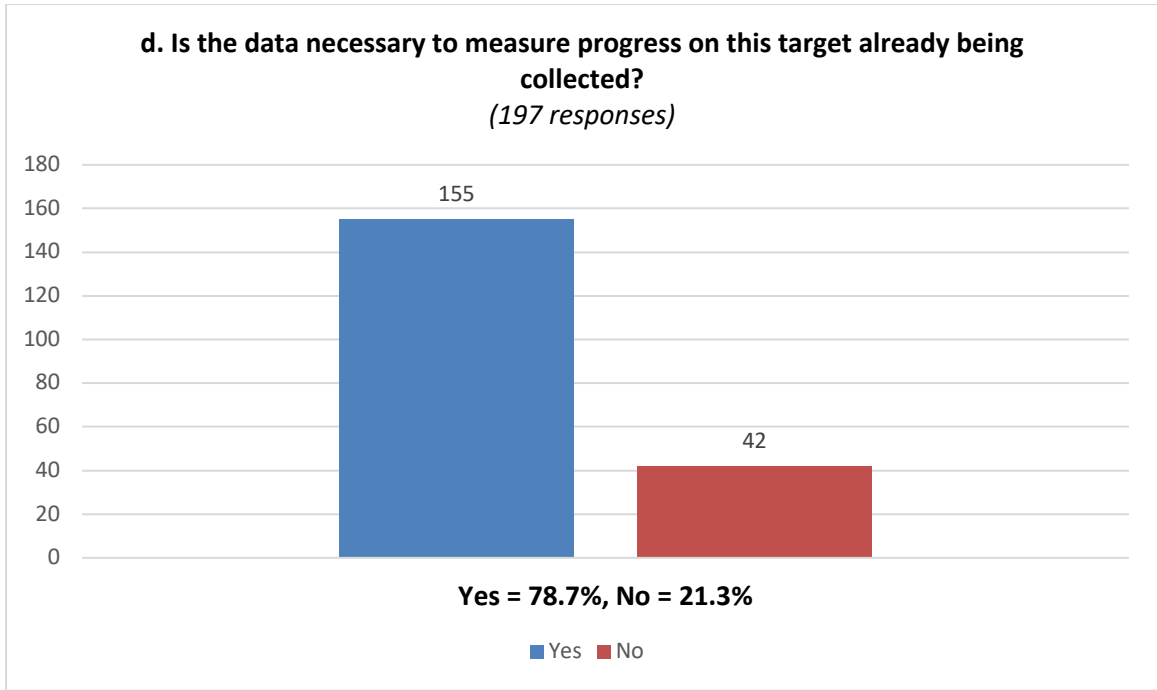

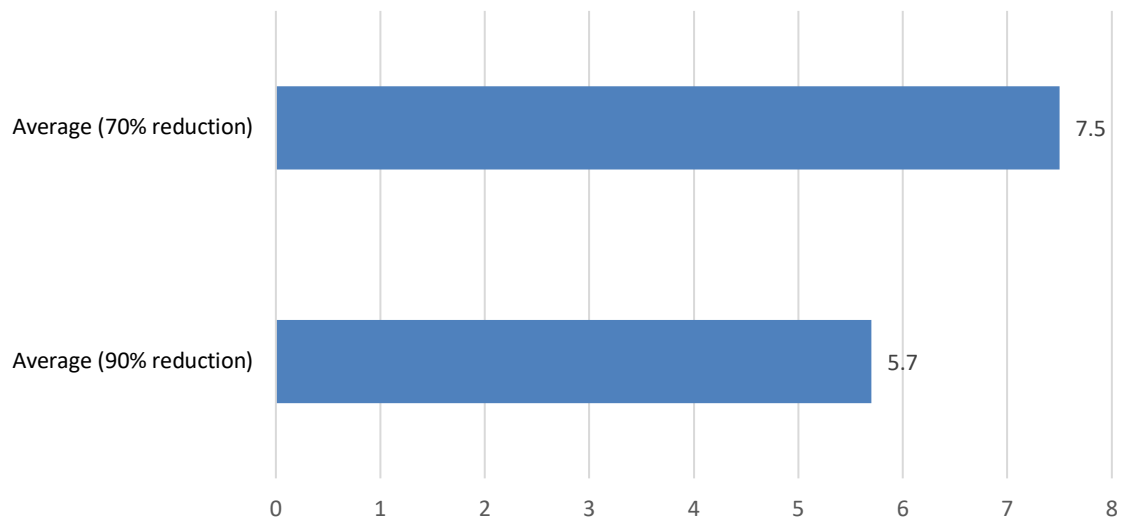
