# PROGRESS TOWARD ZERO LEPROSY

New global leprosy data shows the path to disease elimination

### **Incidence**



127 000 people diagnosed in 96 countries



9 000 children included in new diagnoses



7 000 newly diagnosed people with grade-2 disability

#### **Successes**



>88% of MDT treatments completed



15+ countries have used SDR-PEP to reduce transmission\*



11 countries are working with the Global Partnership for Zero Leprosy

# **Challenges**



COVID-19 disrupted active case-finding



Stigma prevents people from seeking care



130 discriminatory laws remain in 23 countries\*

## **Action Needed**



Close contacts receive a single dose of rifampicin to stop transmission



Country ownership and national programme leadership



Meaningful engagement of persons affected
